And there dis data about the four main challenges based on the findings, which are difficultly in sharing the leaders vision, poor communication skills, lack of self-confidence, and lack of motivation. Finally, it shows the ways in which leadership of university leaders could be improved, such as length of experience, and it highlights the possible inadequacies of formal leadership development for academic leaders in higher education in Iraqi Kurdistan.
