This death has far-reaching implications for the peace between the kingdoms, and Fidelma must work to find out what happened to Dacan before a bloody war breaks out between the many factions and families of sixth century Ireland.

At the outset of the twentieth century, the Nivkhi of Sakhalin Island were a small population of fishermen under Russian dominion and an Asian cultural sway. The turbulence of the decades that followed would transform them dramatically. While Russian missionaries hounded them for their pagan ways, Lenin praised them; while Stalin routed them in purges, Khrushchev gave them respite; and while Brezhnev organized complex resettlement campaigns, Gorbachev pronounced that they were free to resume a traditional life. But what is tradition after seven decades of building a Soviet world? Energy Harvesting Autonomous Sensor Systems

From 2001 to 2007, remittance receipts reported in the IMF's Balance of payments statistics yearbook (measured as global receipts of "workers' remittances" and "compensation of employees") more than doubled to US\$336 billion. This sharp increase is linked to rising migration and labor mobility, more liberal and competitive financial intermediaries, and improved data recording. For some countries, receipts from remittances exceed receipts from the export of goods and services and from financial inflows on foreign direct investment. Despite the high level of interest in remittances, evidence suggests that data on remittances are less reliable than are data on many other items in the balance of payments accounts. Emerging from the January 2005 World Bank/IMF meeting was a consensus that a process for improving data on remittances required

two steps: first, simplifying, clarifying, and expanding the definitions of remittance-related items to meet the needs of data users; second, developing practical compilation guidance to support compilers. The purpose of this publication is to promote lasting improvements in remittances data.--Publisher's description.
